Saturday Oct 13th All this twenty four hours fine breeze from Eastward and fair weather steered S by E At 6 a m saw a school of small whales lowered the boats the whales was going quick to the windward At 11 a m 7th Boats got fast one of the loose whales got the line on the mouth and parted it at noon boats off after the whales so ends.

Sunday 14th This day commence with fine breeze from Eastward boats off after whales At 1 1/2 p m boats came on board unsuccessful set all the sails look for the whales but saw nothing of them At 6 p m steered S by E Middle and Latter part the same so ends

Monday 15th This day commence with light breeze from Eastward and passing squalls steered S by E Middle and Latter part the same so ends

Tuesday 16th This day commence with fine breeze from N E and fair weather steered S S E At 2 p m saw the Island of Madurea Through the steered between the Island of Madurea and Porto Santo At 6 a m steered S S W so ends.

Wednesday Oct 17th This day commence with fine N E wind and fair weather steered S S W At 3 p m steered S W by S 1/2 S Through the night the same Latter part steered S by E so ends

Thursday 18th This day commence with fine N E wind and passing clouds steered S by W At 3 p m saw Teneriffe luf up S by E Through the night lay off and on of the Island At 7 a m keep her off for the town at 10 a m came to anchor in 17 fathoms of water Employed in getting ready to fell ground tier with fresh water so ends

Friday 19th All this twenty four hours light breeze and fine weather Employed in pumping the salt water off the ground tier so ends

Saturday 20th All this twenty four hours fine weather Employed in setting up rigging and ship duty so ends

Sunday 21st All this twenty four hours light breeze and fine weather still at anchor so ends.

Monday 22^d All this twenty four hours light breeze and good weather got 65 bbls of water from the water boat hands employed in ship duty so ends.
