Thursday 8th This day commence with light breeze from N^E and good weather steered S^W by W saw a Sch to the S of us at 9 p m spoke her E B Canwell Middle part the same Latter part saw Bonavista and Salt Island so ends

Friday 9th This day commence with light breeze and good weather steered S^W by W Throught the night the same Latter part fine breeze at noon came to anchor in Isle of Mayo so ends

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Saturday Nov 10th This day commence with fine weather Employed in repairing the L Boat and also painted the W Boat and B Boat inside so ends.

Sunday 11th All this twenty four hours light breeze and fine weather still at anchor in 14 fathoms of water so ends.

Monday 12th All this day fine weather finish repairing the L Boat and painted her inside and painted the other boats out side so ends.

Tuesday 13th All this day light breeze and good weather painted the L Boat out side sold some flour and petroleum on board of Sch so ends.

Wednesday 14th All this day light breeze and good weather Employed in repairing the wheel and ship duty so ends.

Thursday 15th All this day light breeze and good weather had two men to runaway, Manoel Lemeos and Joao Soares sold 5 bbls of flour and 4 of petroleum so ends. heard nothing of runaways
