Saturday 17th Commence with light breeze and calm Sold 5 bbls of flour and some more petroleum two men runaway Jose Cabral, and Manoel Gomes so ends.

Sunday 18th All this twenty four hours light breeze and good weather heard nothing of runaways so ends

Monday 19th This day commence with light breeze and good weather At 2 p m got underway and proceed to sea sail with out runaways so ends

Tuesday 20th This day commence with good weather at daylight off St Jago At 9 A m Capt went on shore vessel lay off and on of the Island at 2 p m boat came on board loaded with Oranges and bananas had two men to runaway Florence L. Proya, and Jose Andrade, so ends.

Wednesday Nov 21st This day commence with fine breeze and good weather got 6 men to come board last night Throught the night weather the same At 7 1/2 a m Capt went on shore and got the Consul to come on board and shipped the men got some more Oranges the name of the men shipped to day is Manoel Souza, Jose Gomes Silva, Pedro Cardozo, Justimano Maria, Ignacio Gomes, Candido Silva, Pedro Freira so we proceed to sea so ends. and with out runaways.

Thursday 22^d All this twenty four hours fine breeze from N E and good weather steered S S W Employed in ship duty so ends

Friday 23^d All this day fine breeze from N E and good weather steered S S W stow the cable below and lashed the anchor so ends.

Saturday 24th All this day fine N E wind and good weather steered S S W hands Employed in ship duty so ends

Sunday 25th All this day fine breeze from N E and passing clouds steered S S W so ends.
