Monday Nov 26<sup>th</sup> First and Middle part this twenty four hours light breeze from N<sup>E</sup> and cloudy weather steered S<sup>S</sup>W<sup>W</sup> Latter part calm and rainy weather so ends.

Tuesday 27<sup>th</sup> All this twenty four hours light breeze from Northward and rain squalls steered S<sup>S</sup>W<sup>W</sup> hands Employed in ship duty Capt sick with bad cold so ends.

Wednesday 28<sup>th</sup> All this day light Northerly wind and rainy weather steered S<sup>S</sup>W<sup>W</sup> Capt still sick and two more men hands Employed in ship duty so ends.

Thursday 29<sup>th</sup> All this day light breeze from Northward and rain squalls steered S<sup>S</sup>W<sup>W</sup> by S Capt, second mate, and two men sick with bad cold so ends

Friday 30<sup>th</sup> All this day light breeze from Northward and rain squalls. steered S<sup>S</sup>W<sup>W</sup> by S Capt feel better second mate and 3 men sick so ends.

Saturday Dec 1<sup>st</sup> All this twenty four hours light air from N<sup>E</sup> and calm with rain squalls steered S<sup>S</sup>W<sup>W</sup> by W second mate and three men still sick so ends.

Sunday 2<sup>d</sup> All this twenty four hours light air from Northward and calm headed S<sup>S</sup>W<sup>W</sup> by W second mate and three men still sick off duty so ends.

Monday 3<sup>d</sup> All this day light air and calm headed to the Southward second mate and two men sick so ends

Tuesday 4<sup>th</sup> All this twenty four hours light breeze from Eastward and calm steered S<sup>S</sup>W<sup>W</sup> second mate 2 men sick so ends.

Wednesday 5<sup>th</sup> All this twenty four hours light air from N<sup>E</sup> and cloudy weather steered S<sup>S</sup>W<sup>W</sup> by S second mate and three men sick Employed in making spunyarn so ends.
