

Saturday Dec 29th 1883.
All this twenty four hours fine breeze from
N.E. and cloudy weather Employed in ship
duty at 7 a m saw a whaling Brig ^{W. H. Hall}
did not spoke her keep Ignacio in irons
so ends Lat 29:28 Long 24:04

Sunday 30th All this twenty four
hours light breeze from Westward and cloudy
weather steered S.W. under of all sails keep
Ignacio in irons so ends

Monday 31st All this day light
breeze and calm headed S.W. hands Employed
in ship duty took Ignacio off the irons and
send him inside of one the try pots to scour
it so ends.

Tuesday January 1st 1884
This day commence with calm weather
and passing clouds headed S.W. At 5 p m
put Ignacio in irons and put him down
in the hole Middle part light breeze from
S.W. headed to S.E. Latter part cloudy and
rain squalls At 8 A m took Ignacio off
the irons and set him scouring the try pots
so ends.

1884
Wednesday Jan 2^d This day
commence with fine breeze from South and
cloudy weather headed S.E. At 3 p m wore ship
head S.W. At 5 p m put Ignacio in irons
and put him down in hole Middle part the
same Latter part steered S.W. by S At 8 a m
set Ignacio scouring the try pots hands Employ-
ed in ship duty so ends

Thursday 3^d First part this
day wind S.E. and passing clouds steered S.W.
by S Middle and Latter part wind hauled to
the Eastward keep Ignacio scouring the try pot
day time night put him on irons and put him
in after hole hands Employed in cleaning
the mincing machine so ends

Friday 4th All this day had
fine breeze from S.E. and good weather steered
S.S.W. hands Employed in ship duty keep
Ignacio scouring the try pot daytime at night
put him in irons so ends.

Saturday 5th This day commence
with fine breeze from S.E. and good weather
steered S.S.W. Middle and Latter part wind
hauled to the Northward hands Employed in
ship duty set Ignacio scouring the try pots
day time night put him in irons and put
him in the after hole so ends.
