Thursday Jan 24th All this day strong breeze from Southward and cloudy weather Bk under of short sails still cruising so ends.

Friday 25th All this twenty four hours strong breeze from WNW and passing clouds headed to the Northward under of short sails so ends.

Saturday 26th First part this day strong breeze from WNW headed to the Northward Middle and Latter part fine breeze and better weather so ends.

Sunday 27th All this twenty four hours fine breeze from Westward and fair weather headed to the Northward still cruising so ends.

Monday 28th All this twenty four hours light breeze from NNE and calm headed to the Eastward hands Employed in ship duty so ends.

Tuesday Jan 29th All this twenty four hours light breeze from Northward and good weather headed to the Eastward hands Employed in ship duty so ends.

Wednesday 30th First and Middle part this twenty four hours fine breeze from Northward and good weather headed to the Eastward Latter part wind hauled NNE and breeze up fresh with cloudy weather headed NE so ends.

Thursday 31st This day commence with strong breeze from NW and some squalls headed NE by N At 2 1/2 p m reef the top sails at 5 p m squally and rainy Through the night cloudy and windy wind hauled NW steered NE Latter part the same so ends.

Friday Feb 1st This twenty four hours commence with fresh NW gale and cloudy weather steered NE under double reef top sails and foresail Through the night gale moderate wind hauled to SE Latter part light breeze and fair weather Employed in breaking out for provision and saw a whaling Bk to the Eastward of us so ends.
