

Monday Feb 11th This day commence with light breeze from Northward and fair weather headed to the Westward Middle part the same Latter part fine breeze Com Morris insight so ends.

Tuesday 12th This day commence with fresh breeze from Northward and cloudy weather steered several different courses At 2 p m Com Morris went out of sight Middle part light breeze Latter part fresh breeze and squally headed to the Northward still cruising so ends.

Wednesday 13th This day commence with light breeze from Westward & passing clouds headed to the Northward rose new fore top mast stay sail sheet Middle part rainy Latter part squally weather steered N E by N still cruising so ends.

Thursday 14th First part this day fresh breeze from S W and cloudy weather steered N E Middle part rainy Latter part better weather Employed in repairing the maintop sail so ends.

Friday Feb 15th First and Middle part this day fine breeze from S E and good weather steered N E Latter part light breeze Employed in repairing the gafftop sail and foretop mast stay sail so ends.

Saturday 16th All this day light variable winds and fair weather headed N E hands Employed in ship duty so ends.

Sunday 17th All this day light breeze and calm headed to N E still cruising so ends.

Monday 18th All this twenty four hours light breeze from Southward and calm headed N E At 11 a m saw a lone whale going quick to the windward lowered the boats at noon boats off so ends.

Tuesday 19th Commence with light breeze from Southward and fair weather boats off after the whale At 4 p m W Boat got on the whale the boatster Jose Bents miss him At 8 p m the boats came on board Middle and Latter part weather the same still cruising saw nothing so ends.
