Sunday 2^d All this twenty four hours light breeze from Eastward and calm still cruising so ends.

Monday 3^d First and Middle part this day light wind and calm Latter part light breeze from N N E and cloudy weather headed N W still cruising so ends.

Tuesday 4th First part this day light breeze from N E and fine rain headed N W by N Middle part calm Latter part wind S S E and cloudy weather still cruising so ends.

Wednesday 5th This day commence with fine S S E wind & cloudy weather headed W S W Middle and Latter part light breeze from S S E and calm headed to the Southward hands Employed in ship duty still cruising so ends.

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Thursday March 6th All this day light breeze from S S E and calm headed to the Southward hands Employed in ship duty so ends.

Friday 7th This day commence with light breeze from S S E and good weather headed to the Southward repaired the fore gall sail and send up fore gall yard and bent the sail on Middle and Latter part weather the same At 8 a m unbent the main stay sail and up the patchers off for patching foresail at 9 a m unbent the foresail Employed in repairing it still cruising so ends.

Saturday 8th All this twenty four hours light winds from Eastward and calm Employed in repairing the foresail at noon finish it and bent it on still cruising so ends.

Sunday 9th This day commence with light breeze from Eastward and good weather headed S S E under of all sails at 6 p m steered S W at 6 A m saw school whales lowered the boats L Boat got one W Boat got another At 11 A m got the whales long side Employed in getting ready to cut the whales in so ends.
