Tuesday 18th This day commence with thick fog Employed in breaking out for provision and towline Through the night weather the same At 10 a m cleared up so ends

Wednesday 19th This day commence with light breeze from S W and cloudy weather At 2 1/2 p m had squally weather and rainy At 3 1/2 p m cleared up and breeze up from Southward Through the night strong breeze and cloudy Latter part more moderate steered N wind hauled S E hands Employed in ship duty still cruising so ends.

Thursday 20th This day commence with fine breeze from S E & fair weather steered N E At 2 p m steered E 1/2 N Middle and Latter part fresh breeze and cloudy weather Employed in ship duty still cruising so ends

Friday March 21st This day commence with strong breeze from Eastward and cloudy weather headed to the Northward Through the night squally and rainy wind N N E Latter part strong breeze were ship headed to the Eastward still cruising so ends.

Saturday 22^d Commence with fresh breeze from N N E and cloudy headed to the Eastward under of short sails Middle part rainy and squally Latter part light wind from S W and calm Employed in ship duty still cruising so ends.

Sunday 23^d This day commence with light breeze from Northward and calm headed E under of all sails Through the night calm and rainy Latter part light breeze from Southward still cruising so ends

Monday 24th All this twenty four hours light breeze from S E and fair weather headed E N E Employed in breaking out for water and provision still cruising so ends.
