Saturday 5th This day commence with fine breeze from S^o E and cloudy weather headed N^o E Employed in breaking out for provisions & water Middle and Latter part strong breeze & squally furlled the light sails no obs. no ends.

Sunday 6th This day commence with strong S^o E wind and squally weather Bk under of topsails steered N^o E by E At 4 1/2 p m commence to rain At 8 p m finish raining Through the night light breeze and cloudy weather Latter part good weather Bk under of all sails so ends
Lat 23° 15' Long 35° 42'

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Monday April 7th This day commence with light breeze from S^o E and fair weather steered N^o E by E Bk under of all sails Middle and Latter part headed N^o E at 8 p m unhook the flyjib and repaired it at noon finish it and bent it on so ends

Tuesday 8th This day commence with light S^o E trades and fair weather headed N^o E by E under of all sails Middle part the same Latter part wind hauled & headed N^o by E hands Employed in ship duty so ends

Wednesday 9th This day commence with light breeze from Northward and good weather headed N^o W At 1 p m tack ship headed E Middle and Latter part the same hands Employed in ship duty so ends

Thursday 10th This day commence with light breeze from N^o E and good weather headed to the Eastward At 4 p m tack ship headed N^o by W 1/2 W Middle and Latter part headed N hands Employed in ship duty so ends

Friday 11th All this day light breeze from Eastward and passing squalls headed N^o E under of all sails hands Employed in ship duty so ends
