ends

Monday 19th This day com-
mence with fine Easterly wind and
good weather steered N W at 2 p m
steered N At 5 p m saw Barbados bears E
Dist 15 miles Middle and Latter part try to get
up to the Island At 11 a m lowered W Boat
Capt went on shore so ends.

Tuesday 20th Commence with
fine weather lay on and off the Island at
4 p m boat came on board Through the
night the same At 9 a m boat went
on shore so ends

Wednesday 21st Commence
with fine weather At 4 p m boat came
on board through the night lay off and on
of the Island At 9 a m boat went on shore
At noon Capt came on board and proceed
to sea steered for Dominica so ends

Thursday 22^d All this twenty four
hours fine breeze and good weather Steered
for Dominica hands Employed in ship duty
so ends

Friday May 23^d Commence
with fine breeze and good weather steered for
Dominica at 2 p m saw Martinique at
7 p m lay to and lay back Through the
the same Latter part keep her for Dominica
saw the Island At 3 p m came to anchor
in seven fathoms of water so ends this day
with 36 hours to begin the harbour log

Saturday 24th All this twenty
four hours cloudy and rainy weather
washed the vessel out side Still rainy so
ends

Sunday 25th All this twenty
four hours better weather still at anchor
so ends

Monday 26th All this day
light breeze and good weather Employed in
washing the vessel in side masts &c &c
so ends.
