Thursday June 5th This day commence with fine breeze and fair weather Employed in ship duty at 4 p m got underway and proceed to sea so ends

Friday 6th This day commence with calm weather through the day fine breeze steered for St Eustatius go there after yams at 7 p m luf to and lay back all night so ends

Saturday 7th This day commence with fine breeze and good weather at daylight keep her off at 8 1/2 a m came to anchor in 7 fathoms of water through the day Employed in getting ready to paint the vessel inside so ends.

Sunday 8th This day commence with fine weather At 2 p m had heavy rain shower so ends

Monday 9th Commence with fair weather at 6 a m commence to paint the vessel inside through the day Employed in painting her at 6 p m finish painted so ends

Tuesday June 10th Commence with fair weather in the afternoon had some rain Employed in ship duty so ends.

Wednesday 11th Commence with fair weather received from on shore the yams and sweet potatoes and stow them away so ends

Thursday 12th This day commence with light breeze and good weather At 4 p m weighed the anchor and proceed to sea so ends

Friday 13th This day commence with fine breeze and good weather At 7 1/2 a m got through Lombroso passage through the day Employed in unbent the cable and stow the anchor so ends

Saturday 14th This day commence with fine breeze and good weather headed NNE hands Employed in ship duty so ends
