Tuesday 12th First and Middle part this twenty four hours light breeze from N^oE and fair weather headed to the Northward Latter part calm still cruising Employed in setting up the bowsprit shrouds and head gears so ends. Lat 36°46 Long 36°30

Wednesday 13th All this twenty four hours light air from Westward and calm headed to the northward hands Employed in ship duty still cruising so ends. Lat 36°57 Long 36°34

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Thursday Aug 14th First and Middle part this twenty four hours light breeze from Westward and good weather steered E^oN^oE Latter part fresh breeze and rainy weather at noon cleared up hands Employed in ship duty so ends. Lat 37°36 Long 35°05

Friday 15th First and Middle part this twenty four hours strong breeze and squally weather headed E by N Latter part Bk under of all sails still cruising so ends. Lat 38°11 Long 33°55

Saturday 16th First part this twenty four hours light breeze from Northward and good weather steered E^oN^oE Middle part calm Latter part the same Employed in patching the foresail and bent it on again so ends. Lat 38°23 Long 33°15

Sunday 17th First and Middle part this twenty four hours fine breeze from S^oW and fair weather steered E^oN^oE under of all sails At 5 a m saw Island of Flores At 8 a m strong breeze and rainy at noon wind hauled to Northward and cleared up so ends.
