

Wednesday Aug 27th This day commence with fine breeze from Eastward and fair weather At 1 p m Capt went on shore after recruits at 5 p m he came on board with some potatoes and onions Middle and Latter part headed E S E so ends

Thursday 28th All this twenty four hours fine breeze from N E and fair weather Bk cruising to the northward of St Miguel Island insight so ends

Friday 29th All this twenty four hours light breeze and calm Bk cruising to the northward of St Miguel saw Brig Gazelle, cruising so ends

Saturday 30th All this twenty four hours light breeze from Eastward and calm still cruising saw the Islands saw the whaling brig Gazelle so ends

Sunday 31st All this twenty four hours light breeze from Westward and good weather cruising off the Terceira saw two whaling vessels so ends

Monday Sept 1st All this twenty four hours light breeze and fine weather still cruising between the Islands saw one whaler so ends.

Tuesday 2^d First part this twenty four hours fine breeze Middle part calm Latter part good breeze from N W Bk still cruising saw a whaling Bk a Brig and two more sails the Islands insight so ends.

Wednesday 3^d All this twenty four hours light breeze from S W and calm still cruising Islands insight saw 3 whaling vessels cruising hands Employed in ship duty so ends.

Thursday 4th This day commences with fine breeze from Westward Middle part calm Latter part light breeze 2 whalers insight, still cruising with Islands insight so ends

Friday 5th First part this day light breeze and good weather Middle part calm Latter part light Westerly wind cruising of Terceira hands Employed in ship duty so ends.
