Tuesday 7th Commence with fine weather starboard watch came on board 5 men runaway, Regado dos Santos, Clemente dos Santos, Manoel Souza, Benjamin Rodrigues, and Cando Silva, sent the port watch on shore so ends

Wednesday 8th Commence with fine weather the port watch came on board 4 men runaway, Manoel Machado, Manoel Silveira, Jose Gomes Silva, Justuniano Maria received recruits from on shore so ends

Thursday 9th This day commence with fresh breeze from SE and squally weather last night two more men runaway, Ignacio Gomes, and Pedro Freire hands employed in ship duty shipped two boatsterns Manoel Gomes, and Antonio Baptista heard nothing of runaways so ends.

Friday Oct 10th Commence with fresh SE Windes and squally weather hands employed in ship duty heard nothing of deserters so ends.

Saturday 11th Commence with fresh SE wind and squally weather hands employed in ship duty shipped 3 men Manoel Trank Silva, Sebastiao Antone, Antonio Antao, heard nothing from the deserters so ends.

Sunday 12th All this twenty four hours fresh SE wind and cloudy weather heard nothing from the deserters so ends

Monday 13th Commence with strong SE wind and squally weather got our whale boats all on board and got ready for sea heard nothing from runaways so ends.

Tuesday 14th This day commence with fresh SE wind at 10 A.M. commence unmooring the vessel the Bark Tamerlane shes alongside of us and going to day at 4 P.M. the Tug boat hauled her off at 5 1/2 P.M. the Tug took us out so ends laying off and on of the Island.

Wednesday 15th Commence with fresh breeze the Tamerlane and Ohio lay off and on waiting for runaways the Capts on shore so ends. got two Portuguese on board that stow them selves in St Michael, Augusto Almeida and Manoel Leal.
