Through the Barks lay off and on latter
part the same so ends.

Monday 17th Commence with
good weather at 1 p m boat went on shore
at 2 Capt came on board with the American
consul to ship 8 of the portuguese he got in
stores 2 of them shipped and 4 did not want
to ship At 3 p m the Capt and Consul
went on shore and shipped 3 more men
Jo Lopez, Francisco Fustado and Jaim
Brown At 8 p m Capt came on board
and proceed to sea steered S by W Middle
and latter part the same so ends.

Tuesday 18th Commence with
fine N E trades and good weather steered S
by W went the cables and lashed the
anchors and stow the cables below so ends.

fine N E trades and good weather steered
S by W hands Employed in ship duty so ends

Thursday 20th All this twenty
four hours light N E trades and fair weather
steered S by W hand Employed in ship duty
so ends

Friday 21st All this twenty
four hours light N E trades and cloudy
weather steered S by W painted the S Boat
hands Employed in ship duty so ends

Saturday 22^d All this day
light trades and calm steered S by W hands
Employed in ship duty so ends.

Sunday 23^d All this twenty
four hours light variable winds and
calm steered S by W so ends

Monday 24th All this twenty
four hours light variable winds and rain
squalls steered S by W Employed in breaking
out for provisions coopered the provision
casks & ship duty so ends.
