

Thursday Dec 4th Commence
with calm weather at 2 p m commence
boiling the blackfish at 4 finish boiling
Middle and Latter part light breeze from
SE stow the oil down at 9 a m saw
blackfish lowered the boats L Boat got one
W Boat got another so ends.

Lat 5° 30' N Long 23° 16'

Friday 5th Commence with
light breeze from SE headed SW Employed
in mousing the blubber Middle and Latter
part calm at 7 a m unbent the Spunkier
Employed in repairing it so ends

Lat 5° 11' N Long 23° 34'

Saturday 6th Commence with
calm weather at 2 p m finish the Spunkier and
bent it on, started fire and boiled the black-
fish at 5 p m finish boiling Middle and
Latter part still calm at 8 a m stow
the oil below at noon weather squally
so ends no obs.

Sunday 7th Commence
with light air from NE and rainy weather
headed to the Southward at 3 p m cleared
up fine weather Middle part light air
and calm Latter part light breeze from SE
headed to the Southward at noon calm
and cloudy so ends. no obs

Monday Dec 8th All this twenty
four hours light air calm and rain squalls
headed W by W at noon no obs so ends

Tuesday 9th All this twenty
four hours light breeze from Southward calm
and rain squalls headed W by W Hoisted the
old fore gall sail Latter part bent on new
one still cloudy so ends Lat 4° 42' N Long

Wednesday 10th Commence
with light air and calm headed W by W
Middle part light breeze Latter part fine
breeze and cloudy weather headed SE by W
under of all sails no obs so ends

Thursday 11th Commence
with fine breeze and cloudy weather saw
blackfish lowered the boats and got one
Bark headed W by W moused the blackfish
blubber Middle and Latter part light breeze
and cloudy so ends.
