

Friday Dec 12<sup>th</sup> Commence with light breeze from Southward and cloudy weather headed 9<sup>th</sup> by 11<sup>th</sup> Middle part the same At 8 A m saw Whales going quick to the windward at 9 A m lowered the boats at 11 a m all the boats got fast so ends with boats off.

Saturday 13<sup>th</sup> Commence with good weather At 4 p m W Boat, and B Boat got alongside with one whale each At 7 p m I Boat and L Boat got long side with two whales each making 6 whales Through the night Employed in getting the gear up and get ready to cut whales in at 6 A m commence cutting at noon get 3 whales in so ends Lat 42° 1' N Long 24° 45'

Sunday 14<sup>th</sup> Commence with fine breeze from Southward and cloudy weather Employed in cutting the whales in at 9 p m finish cutting at 10 p m Commence to rain Through the night rainy and squally Latter part had several rain squalls At 8 a m started the fire all hands on deck at work on the blubber so ends

Lat 41° 53' N Long 24° 26'

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Monday Dec 15<sup>th</sup> This day commence with rain and squally weather all hands at work cutting blubber in horse pieces at 6 1/2 p m send one watch below Through the night finish cutting the blubber Latter part still boiling and cutting the head the weather squally so ends

Tuesday 16<sup>th</sup> All this day Employed in boiling and cutting the heads had several rain squalls so ends.

Wednesday 17<sup>th</sup> Commence with rain squalls and cloudy weather Employed in boiling and at work At 5 p m it rain so hard we let the fire go out Through the night rainy and squally At 7 a m stop boiling started the fire again and boiled the head in water we pumped 3 casks in ground tier and got ready to stow the oil down no obs so ends.

Thursday 18<sup>th</sup> Commence with calm and rain squalls Employed in boiling and at work at 8 p m finish boiling Middle and Latter part had several rain squalls At 7 1/2 a m commence stow down the oil on ground tier so ends no obs.
