

Monday Jan 19th First part this day light breeze from NW and rain squalls steered NNE Middle part the same Latter part light breeze and cloudy weather ran new gunlines and main top sail reef tackle Employed in making bungs & ship duty so ends no obs

Tuesday 20th This day commence with light breeze and calm headed to the Eastward Middle part light winds and rainy weather Latter part calm Employed in making bungs & ship duty no obs so ends.

Wednesday 21st This day commence with light air from SE and rain squalls steered NNE Through the night light breeze from NE by E headed to Northward and rain squalls Latter part wind the same but bitter weather Employed in coopers work & work on the rigging Bark under of all sails so ends Lat 17° 47' S Long 36° 56'

Thursday 22^d Commence with fine breeze from ENE and fair weather headed N Middle and Latter part headed NNE hands Employed in ship duty so ends Lat 17° 07' S Long 37° 28'

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Friday Jan 23^d This day commence with fine breeze from NE and cloudy weather headed ESE hands Employed in ship duty at sun down short in sails Middle part the same Latter part light breeze and cloudy so ends Lat 17° 47' Long 37° 00'

Saturday 24th Commence with light breeze from NE and passing squalls headed ESE by E Middle and Latter part fine breeze and squally weather hands Employed in ship duty unbent the main stay sail & stow it below so ends Lat 18° 34' S Long 35° 56'

Sunday 25th All this twenty four hours fine breeze from Northward & passing squalls headed to the Eastward Bark under of all sails so ends Lat 18° 13' Long 34° 45'

Monday 26th This day commence with light breeze from N and passing squalls headed ENE Middle part strong breeze Latter part the same Employed in ship duty so ends Lat 17° 52' S Long 33° 11'
