steered W 1/2 N Middle and Latter part the
same Employed in working on rigging so ends
Lat 13° 08' Long 54° 1/3'

Tuesday 3^d Commence with
fine N E trades and passing clouds steered
W 1/2 N Middle and Latter part the same
Employed in working on rigging & ship duty
so ends
Lat 13° 14' Long 57° 1/4'

Wednesday March 4th This
day commence with fine N E trades and
fair weather steered W Middle part the
same At 7 A m saw the Island of Barbados
hands Employed in ship duty so ends.

Thursday 5th This day
commence with fine breeze from N E
and fair weather At 3 p m Capt went
on shore at 6 p m boat came on board
Middle part the same at 9 A m boat
went on shore Bark lay off and on
so ends

Friday 6th This day
commence with fine weather at 3 p m
boat came on board with 8 bbls
of flour and a sheep pumpkin Middle
part the weather the same at 9 A m
sent the boat on shore so ends.

Saturday 7th Commence
with fine weather at 3 p m Capt came
on board and steered for Dominica
Middle and Latter part the same
so ends.
