× Sunday March 8th All this twenty four hours fine N.E. trades and good weather steered N.N.W. hands Employed in ship duty so ends

× Monday 9th Commence with fine trades and good weather Dominica brought hands Employed in ship duty so ends

× Tuesday 10th Commence with light trades and good weather at 2 p.m. came to anchor in Dominica in 7 fathoms of water got the gear up for breaking out Middle part the same Latter part Employed in stowing the casks on main hatch and fell them with salt water so ends

× Wednesday 11th fine weather Employed in stowing the vessel and got some wood from on shore so ends

× Thursday March 12th All this day fine weather Employed in breaking out the meat of ground tier and stow the vessel finish getting wood so ends

× Friday 13th All this day good weather Employed in getting fresh water and stow the vessel so ends

× Saturday 14th All this day good weather Employed in rattling the fore and main rigging & ship duty so ends

× Sunday 15th All this day light breeze and good weather so ends

× Monday 16th Commence with fine weather Employed in rattling the fore and main rigging hands Employed in tarring down the rigging so ends
