Wednesday 18th Commence with fine weather received from on board the Sch Lottie & Cook 1246 galls of Sperm oil and one cask of Blackfish contain 126 galls to take it home on freight finish stowing the vessel so ends

Thursday 19th Commence with good weather all hands Employed in washing the vessel in side and out and on ship duty so ends

Friday 20th Commence with good weather Employed in painting the vessel out side and ship duty so ends

Saturday 21st of March Commence with fine weather Employed in parasting the vessel inside and scraping the spars spars on deck so ends the Bask Tropic Bird came in to anchor nothing this season.

Sunday 22^d All this twenty four hours light trades and good weather so ends

Monday 23^d Commence with fine breeze and good weather at 4 p m got underway and proceed to sea so ends

Tuesday 24th All this twenty four hours light breeze and good weather steering through the Islands for the Combsoro passage hands Employed in ship duty so ends
