commence with calm weather At 7 p m
got light breeze from Southward } steered
N^W by W Through the night fine breeze
from S^W Latter part strong breeze and
cloudy weather bent the new Spanker
so ends Lat 36° 52' Long 71° 15'

Thursday 9th This day com-
mence with strong breeze from S^W and
cloudy weather steered N^W by W At 3 p m
commence to rain At 4 p m stop raining
wind hauled N^W and blow hard close
reefed the top sails at 1 a m furled the
fore top sail having gale wind Latter part
the same at 10 a m wore ship headed W
N^W so ends Back under of short sails
bent the fore top mast stay sail.
