

Ship Omega in the North Atlantic Ocean

Remarks Tuesday February 2^d 1847

First part of these 24 hours gentle breeze from the North course South by West all sail out employed in furling and other jobs

Middle part strong breeze course South by West at 8 AM was under the necessity of seizing Lines & Pins in the Main rigging for indubination

Later part fine fresh trades and fair weather course South by West employed in furling out all three hatch ways trying to put things under deck

Latit 14° 18' Long 14° 49' West

Remarks Wednesday February 3^d 1847

First part of these 24 hours fresh trades and fair weather course South by West

at daylight set the fore topmast steering sail and lower steering sail

Later part fine fresh trades and fair weather all hands employed in getting ship for whaling

Latit 14° 12' Long 14° 14'

Remarks Thursday 4th

commenced with gentle trades and fine pleasant weather course South by West

Middle part stiff breeze and fair

Later part fine fresh trades and fair weather all hands employed in getting the fore top gallant rigging

Latit Long

Steering towards the Cape de Verde Islands A.D. 1847

First part of these 24 hours fine fresh trades and fair weather (course S by West) at 4 PM saw hump backs leaved in pursuit but did not strike

Middle part fine weather and wind East by South course South by West all sail out at daylight saw the Island of St. Anthony bearing South West by East dist 45 miles

Later part light air inclining aft set the steering sails Latit 17° 44' Long 14° 54' West

Remarks Saturday 6th 1847

First part of these 24 hours gentle breeze from the Eastward course South East West steering 1 point clear of the S West point of St. Anthony

Middle part gentle breeze course South all sail out Later part gentle breeze St. Anthony bearing East by North dist 7 leagues

Remarks Sunday 7th

First part of these 24 hours strong breeze course South all sail out

Middle part strong breeze all sail out course South by West at daylight saw the Island of Pavo Pavo bearing East by North dist 30 miles

Later part fresh trades all sail out the Omega knocking the water bang for a sail

Latit 18° 57' Long 16° 45' West
