MARCH. Friday the 30th 1849

⁴⁹ Commences with light air and squally weather steering by heading East wind North by Middle part strong breeze from S. East all Sail out course N. E. by E. East latter part very squally all appearance of a North by wind S. Ends employed variously

Lat 11° 15'
Long 160° 28'

Saturday the 31st

Commences with light baffling winds and very squally wind all around the Company Middle part clear and a brisk breeze from the Eastward steering by heading N. E. East latter part off latter all Sail out fine weather S. Ends

10° 08'
160° 15'

APRIL. Sunday the 1st

Commences with a moderate breeze from North heading to the N. West backed Ship came up East off S. East at sunset was Ship heading N. East wind S. East Middle part light baffling winds off latter sharp lightning and distant thunder all night at daylight more Ship wind North heading East latter part light air S. Ends

Monday the 2^d

Commences with light air from the North heading East Middle part squally and a brisk breeze at daylight Sail lone latter part gentle breeze steering in for the said Island at noon saw an Island bearing East S. Ends

Tuesday the 3^d

Commences with gentle breeze from N. West steering by heading in for the Island of Obitahoo at sunset but one boat in in the S. West side found we could not get water there Middle part light air at daylight wind N. East steering around the Island in pursuit of a bettering place saw the Island of Dominick bearing N. West also 4 other Islands to the N. East Middle part light air at daylight steered around the Island at 12 came too in Resolution Bay in 15 fathoms water S. Ends

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
