APRIL Saturday the 21st

Commences with a brisk breeze from the East Course & beat by land all sail set - Saw a fair bark Middle part a strong breeze latter part inclining more aft - Set the Royal & all the Sticking Sails nothing in sight all looks barren and fruitless

Commences with a moderate breeze - Course & beat by land all possible sail set Middle part much the same and latter part to Le Ends there 24 hours with seeing a School of Porpoises and all hands keeping the Deck

Monday the 23rd

Commences with a moderate breeze from the S. East all sail set Middle part a brisk breeze latter part a moderate breeze Steering Sails down and aloft employed fitting our cutting pennants to Le Ends

Tuesday the 24th

Commences with a moderate breeze course & beat by land all possible sail set Middle part gentle breeze from S. East latter part do employed fitting the Battens Gear and painting the Cabin board boat to Le Ends

Commences with a gentle breeze from S. East Steering Sails down and aloft course & beat employed in Ship's duty Middle part light breeze latter part calm to Le Ends nothing in sight this 24 hours

Thursday the 26th

Commences with light baffling air from the East Course the same Middle part strong breeze from the North heading East & beat at daylight very squally back in light Sails latter part a strong breeze

Ship Omega Steering towards Oahu 1847

APRIL Friday the 27th

Commences with a strong breeze from the North Steering by heading & beat by land a rough head sea running Middle part more moderate latter part light air Saw the Island of Oahu and also the North Point Course & beat by land to Le Ends

Saturday the 28th

Commences with light winds at 4 P.M. Saw the Island of Oahu bearing East by North Course & beat by land and well to the North Middle part gentle breeze latter part much the same at noon saw Mollake steering down by the Island of Maui

Sunday 29

Commences with a gentle breeze from S. East all sail set at sunset off Maui passage steering East by the Island of Mollake steering towards Oahu Middle part brisk breeze at daylight saw Oahu ahead away for Honolulu at 12 came to in 13 fms at the back of Oahu bar found only one ship there and the Merchantman to Le Ends

Monday 30

first part brisk breeze from the S. East at 1 P.M. the Capt. came on shore saw several ships in the harbour and one from Oahu and also coming in at 5 P.M. a boat came off with 20 lbs of potatoes Middle part calm our boat returned at sunset latter part the Capt. came off to Le Ends

Tuesday the 1 May

Commences with brisk breeze at 1 P.M. took our anchor and stood off shore by the wind heading East & beat by land (Middle part) and return on shore John Adams light breeze latter part stood in and the Capt. went on shore to the same men to Le Ends ship laying off and on

Wednesday the 2nd

Commences with light air and pleasant ship laying off and on at 5 P.M. the Capt. came off with 5 potatoes that he shipped here Middle part strong & beat at daylight saw the Island of Oahu bearing East & beat latter part light winds to Le Ends latter off the lee beam

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
