Thursday the 3^d 1849

First part gentle breeze all sail out.
Course R.R. East. Darts in the 4th and 5th boom and
unrigged the Royal Studion Sail gear steamed the anchors
and are already for whales in any shape. Middle part
fine latter part light air and squally
S. Ends employed in Ship's duty

Friday the 4th

Commences with puffing winds and squalls
Middle part steady breeze from R. East
a dry light light air from the R. East
employed in Ship's duty getting Craft ground
for the R. East Coast. Latter part gentle breeze
heading by the way R. East R. East

Saturday the 5th

Commences with gentle breeze from R. East
Heading by heading R. East. all sail out. S. East
down the Studion Sails and Gear. Middle part
light air latter part much the same
up R. East and off R. East S. Ends

Sunday the 6th

Commences with light breeze from the
East. Steady by heading R. East. employed in
Ship's duty. Middle part calm
latter part the same employed keeping
the Sabbath day holy

Monday the 7th

Commences with calm calm calm
Middle part light air from S. East
Set the fore top Mast. Steering Sail
latter part much the same employed
Steering down Oil in the Main Hatchway
at noon finished

Tuesday the 8th

Commences with gentle breeze from the
East inclining to the North all sail out
Steering by heading R. East. Middle part
gentle breeze latter part light breeze from the
R. East heading R. East employed R. East S. Ends

May 1849.

Wednesday the 9th

First part of three 24 hours light breeze from R. East
all sail out Steering by the R. East. S. East. S. East. S. East.
fore top Gallant Sail and last in all hard times
Middle part strong breeze heading R. East
latter part much the same employed making
Spin Yarn and Black Sinter

Thursday the 10th

Commences with a brisk breeze all sail
out Steering by heading R. East. Middle part
light breeze and squally both in the fore top
Gallant Sail and fly Jib. latter part much the same
last down the fore Royal yard and

Friday the 11th

Commences with brisk breeze from the R. East
all sail out Steering by the R. East. S. East.
employed in Ship's duty. Middle part steady breeze
and squally latter part much the same S. East

Saturday the 12th

Commences with light breeze from the R. East
all sail out heading R. East. Middle part
moderate breeze
latter part light air S. East employed
pariously nothing in sight but expect there
will be soon

Sunday the 13th

Commences with light air from the East
Steering by heading R. East. Middle part
Middle part calm calm
latter part the same

Monday the 14th

Commences with light air from the
North Steering by heading R. East. R. East. rather
a poor course and then the 14th of May saw
a School of black fish lowered but could
not get fast. Middle part the same latter
part gentle breeze from the East. Course R. East
employed rigging in an out a Jib boom and fly Jib. Rain
