

Monday the 23^d

First part of the 24 hours gentle breeze from the South all sail out. The Omega out of sight. Middle part fine. Saw a carcass and a lot of humpers. Later part calm employed refueling and oil. Le End fine pleasant weather.

Tuesday the 24th

First part of the 24 hours light air from the South steering S. by E. all sail out. Saw a Bark Ship sailing. Middle part saw a whaling boat chased until 10 o'clock. At 11 came on board could not strike. Saw 2 Ships sailing to the South light air from S. by E. to End.

Wednesday the 25th

First part light air from S. by E. steering by. Chasing East. Saw one Ship cutting and sailing to Ships in sight all sailing. Saw a great number of Whales in sight. Middle part saw a great number of humpers. At 8 A.M. saw a whaling boat chased to boats but could not get lost. We have got our own luck and the devil chased until 12 o'clock. Came on board. Saw 2 Ships cutting and sailing down back luck.

Thursday the 26th

First part moderate breeze from the South. an one tack and in another 5 or 6 Ships in sight cutting and sailing and 4 of the Omega's boats off in pursuit of a whale head and tank. Came at 6 P.M. struck and killed one tank. Then alongside at 7 P.M. commenced cutting at 3 A.M. finished and all hands went below at 7 A.M. called all hands. Saw whaling tubules. Lowered 2 boats chased. Struck one and at noon took him to the Ship. employed sailing. Le End 1 Ship in sight sailing.

Friday the 27th

Commenced with a gentle breeze from the South 2 boats off in pursuit of whales employed sailing. 1 in the lubber room one along side at 3 P.M. boat came on board could not get lost. commenced cutting at 4 finished at 8 1/2 employed sailing. Saw too no sail out. Middle part breeze forward. Standing to the South west under easy sail sailing. 1 Ship in sight in the same employment. Saw a number of humpers but no black whale. Saw a large field of Ice to the South of us.

Saturday the 28th

Commenced with light breeze from the East heading South under all sail sailing. Saw a large field of Ice. Reaching from 2 Points forward of the weather beam to 2 points off the lee bow. Saw also a Bow Head or black whale close to the Ice. Lowered tank. Then alongside one Ship to the South and made all sail to get clear of the Ice employed sailing and Coopering Oil. At 11 P.M. commenced cutting one whale finished at 6 employed sailing and standing down in the After Hatch. Spoke Bark Franklin. Sugar boat had taken 10 whales. Le End.

Sunday the 30th

First part fine gentle breeze from the S. by E. steering off East. S. by E. employed sailing and standing down. Saw the same Bark take a whale. 1 more Ship in sight. Middle part fine. At 5 A.M. struck - killed and took a whale alongside employed sailing and standing down. Saw 2 Ships and their boats down. Working also. Saw the Ice to the Eastward.
