

Saturday the 18

Left at 35th lat Commenced with thick cloudy weather
 Lay 11/2 days and about 100 miles to the S. West
 under a close reef. Main top Sail hauling
 no whales in sight and Ship. Suppose some
 of the Ship's crew out this last blow at 4 PM
 Left the fore Side Still hauling Middle
 part in line at daylight do commenced
 hauling down and in the fore Hold the
 lardered Side better from color saw
 from Mast head of ^{some} paper. Suppose
 some poor fellow in the last blow
 lost them saw also 3 Ship to to the Westward
 Le End employed hauling and Stowing down

Sunday the 19th

Commenced with light air from the South
 under Short Sail hauling back hauling and
 Stowing down

Middle part including fogs
 at daylight finished hauling of Saw
 2 Ship's Stowing to the West

latter part a brisk breeze from
 the N. West under Short Sail Stowing
 to the South and West employed Stowing down
 Oil in the fore Hold. Saw a dead whale
 toward a boat to take him to the Ship found not worth while
 the bone all washed from his head think some Ship lost him
 in the last gale as there was part of a fluke rope
 on him

Monday the 20th

first part of the 24 hours a brisk breeze from
 the S. West finished Stowing down and Made Sail
 heading in to the Westward

Middle part fine Saw whales toward and
 struck and the line parted so lost the whale and 2 men
 struck another killed him and took him alongside
 Commenced Cutting

Tuesday 21st

Commenced with a moderate breeze from
 N. West employed Cutting

Middle part finished Cutting employed
 hauling

latter part a brisk breeze from the Westward
 employed Cutting up Shocks

Saw and putted a Ship with her Main tack
 down heading Southward without any S. B. beam
 Saffron lost it in the Gale of the 18th inst

Wednesday the 22

Strong breeze from S. West under Short Sail
 hauling Saw one Ship Steering to the South East
 toward the Straits

Middle part foggy misty weather and
 cold as the Wind

latter part the same Still hauling and
 Putting up pipe Shocks

Thursday the 23

first part a moderate breeze under Short
 Sail hauling Steering Steering to the South and
 East

Middle part fine Saw some humpies

latter part fine pleasant weather
 and Adair's Giant Mountains in sight all
 covered with Snow
