Thursday the 30<sup>th</sup>

First part of these 24 hours strong gale from the Westward being under bare poles at 4 P.M. set a close reef Main top Sail and fore Sail and stowed away S.E. part for Bearing Straits with 100 bbls of Oil on deck and 50 bbls of blubber in the blubber room and the Ship makes decidedly better weather Middle part Moderating some Made Sail accordingly at daylight saw the land the Asiatic Side of Bearing Straits hauled up for it at noon off Cape East saw the Passage Islands and stowed away for them plenty of Span and plenty of bark this day

Friday the 31<sup>st</sup>

First part of these 24 hours Moderate breeze from the Westward all Sail set Steering through Bearing Straits employed Steering down Oil in the After hold at 6 P.M. inclining S.E. Course S.E. part all Sail set Middle part fine weather at daylight commenced hauling Latter part of gentle breeze from R. Coast saw a Ship ahead of us bound the same Course at noon nearly calm employed hauling

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Saturday the 1<sup>st</sup>

Commenced with light air and fine weather employed hauling all Sail set Steering towards Clark Island which is in sight Middle part fine gentle breeze and pleasant weather Steering by between Clark Island and the Asiatic coast at daylight light air finished hauling employed Steering down in the After hold S. Coast

Sunday the 2<sup>nd</sup>

First part of these 24 hours gentle breeze from the R. Coast Steering down of Clark Island saw one very large Settlement and a great number of natives could not stop busy Steering down Oil and a hulk fair land behind us Middle part much the same at daylight wind hauled to the R. Coast all Sail set Course S.E. part Steering towards Jones Island at noon a high swell and thick weather employed clearing the decks &c

Monday the 3<sup>rd</sup>

First part of these 24 hours a brisk breeze from the R. Coast all Sail set Course S.E. part S. part saw a great number of Sea Gulls Supper Jones Island not part of Middle part thick weather doubled up reef fore and aft at daylight Middle part all Sail Course S. by East of East latter part a brisk breeze from the R. Coast and sunny weather the Omega during the best

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Tuesday the 4<sup>th</sup>

First part of these 24 hours a brisk breeze from the R. Coast all Sail set Course S. part of East of East Middle part a brisk breeze all Sail set Course S. part of East of East Latter part much the same Course Steering down in the After hold Steering down in the After hold natives and one Patagonian

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
