Monday the 5<sup>th</sup>

First part light air and calm toward  
2 boats in pursuit chased them 3 hours could  
not come up with them gave them up  
Middle part a gentle breeze from ESE  
all sail out sharp by the South  
latter part a strong breeze accompanied with  
squalls heading from South to S West 2 men  
off duty and has been ever since as left  
Oahu

Tuesday the 6<sup>th</sup>

4<sup>h</sup> 31 149<sup>h</sup> 02 First part of the 24 hours a strong  
breeze from the S. East all sail out course  
steering by heading South and West Middle part  
a light breeze latter part do heading S. West  
Sharp by employed repairing an old till

Wednesday the 7<sup>th</sup>

First part of the 24 hours a moderate breeze  
from S East all sail out sharp by heading S. West  
Middle part moderate breeze latter part the same  
heading S West most of the time employed repairing  
3<sup>h</sup> 31<sup>h</sup> 151<sup>h</sup> 50

Thursday the 8<sup>th</sup>

First part of the 24 hours a gentle breeze  
from the S East all sail out sharp by heading S. West  
Middle part a gentle breeze heading S. West  
latter part do employed getting lumber Observation  
and for nothing in light S. East  
6<sup>h</sup> 1.58 Long 152.58 East

Friday the 9<sup>th</sup>

First part of the 24 hours a gentle breeze  
from the E. East all sail out sharp by heading S. West  
Middle part a gentle breeze heading S. West  
latter part much the same employed repairing  
an old boat &c

Saturday the 10<sup>th</sup>

Commenced with a gentle breeze from the East  
all sail out heading from S. to S. West  
Middle part the same  
latter part do heading up S. East all sail  
out

Sunday the 11<sup>th</sup> 1849

First part of the 24 hours a moderate  
breeze from the East all sail out heading  
Long 152<sup>h</sup> 45<sup>h</sup> up 1.58 East  
Middle part a light breeze latter  
part the same S. East employed keeping the Sabot

Monday the 12<sup>th</sup>

2<sup>h</sup> 20 First part of the 24 hours a light breeze from  
152<sup>h</sup> 37 the East all sail out sharp by heading S. E.  
Middle part a light breeze  
latter part light breeze a few squalls  
3<sup>h</sup> 43 employed repairing an old boat  
152<sup>h</sup> 50

Tuesday the 13<sup>th</sup>

First part gentle breeze all sail out sharp  
by heading S. East and S. East employed Black  
Weather and other fish Middle part light  
air latter part gentle breeze all sail  
5.18 out heading up S. East  
153<sup>h</sup> 28

Wednesday the 14<sup>th</sup>

Commenced with a light breeze and fine  
pleasant weather all sail out steering by heading  
S. East Middle part very squally  
6.21 latter part do heading S. East  
152.30 at noon set the steering sails S. East

Thursday the 15<sup>th</sup>

Commenced with a moderate breeze all sail  
out course S. E. by East saw a great number  
of birds Middle part inclining squally look  
in the steering sails latter part a strong  
breeze no squalls set the steering sails course  
7.45 S. East by East wind S. East  
152.20

Friday the 16<sup>th</sup>

Commenced with a light breeze all sail out course  
S. East saw Black fish and at night saw a boat  
Luffere sperm whales so near dark could not  
9<sup>h</sup> 41 saw a certain Middle part light air latter do  
150<sup>h</sup> 45 set the steering sails S. East
