Tuesday October 6th 1863

Commenced moderate breezes from S.W. Steering E. by S. Throughout the rest of this day moderate breezes from the W. N. W. Steering E. by S.

Lat 43° 18' S. Long by Chron 118° 52' E

Wednesday Oct 7th

Continued moderate breezes from W. N. W. Steering E. by S. Middle & latter part fresh breezes from N. N. W. Steering E. by S.

Employed in breaking out water &c &c

Lat 43° 52' S. Long by Chron 123° 20' E

Thursday Oct 8th

Fresh breezes the first part of this day from N. N. W. Steering E. by S. Middle part strong breezes and squally. Latter part moderate breezes from the Westward Steering E. by S.

Lat 43° 15' S. Long by Chron 127° 38' E

Friday Oct 9th

Continued moderate breezes from the W. N. W. Steering E. by S. Middle part the same. Latter part strong breezes & squally Steering

Lat 44° 50' S. Long by Chron 132° 04' E

Saturday Oct 10th

Strong breezes & squally from W. N. W. Steering E. by N. the rest of this day strong breezes & squally from the Westward Steering E. by N.

Lat 44° 58' S. Long by Chron 136° 42' E

Sunday Oct 11th

Continued strong breezes from the Westward Steering E. by N. Middle and latter part moderate breezes Steering E. by N.

Lat 44° 57' S. Long by Chron 142° 15' E

Monday Oct 12th

Fresh breezes the first part of this day Steering E. N. E. Middle and latter part fresh breezes Steering E. N. E. and N. E. by E. Saw the land &c

Tuesday October 13th 1863

Continued fresh breezes Saw the South part of Van Diemen Land the Edystone & and 3 Whales one of passed close to us a Whaler showing English colors We are now in the Pacific Ocean only 10 days from Home. Middle part moderate breezes Steering N. E. Latter part fresh breezes from the Eastward Steering by the wind to the N. N. E. Saw 4 Humpbacks. Finbacks & 3 Strange Tails

Lat 43° 10' S. Long by Chron 148° 56' E

Wednesday Oct 14th

First part of this day fresh breezes from the Eastward Steering by the wind to the N. N. E. Middle part wind S. W. Steering N. N. E. Latter part strong breezes from the S. W. Steering North. Saw Finbacks & Porpoises

Lat 40° 33' S. Long by Chron 152° 19' E

Thursday Oct 15th

Continued strong breezes from the South Steering North. Middle part the same Latter part more moderate Saw a Strange Tail and spoke her the Midas of New Bedford. 29 months out 400 bbls most of it Spearm. and fine weather. in company. M.

Lat 38° 08' S

Friday Oct 16th

First part moderate breezes in company with the Midas. Middle part light air heading to the N. W. Light air and Calm the rest of this day. 5 am saw 4 Whales & 60. looked for them and chased chasing the rest of the day. Midas in company

Lat 37° 20' S. Long by Chron 151° 35' E

Saturday Oct 17th

Continued light air heading for the Whales but could not come up with them 5 bells took up the boats. no fish. Middle part light air Latter part moderate heading N. W. by N. Saw Finbacks and 3 Tails. So ended

Lat by Chron 36° 55' S. Long 151° 20' E
