Continues Strong breeze and rain from the Westward Steering N. E. 6 P.M. Steered N. E. by E. Middle part the same. Latter part more moderate Steering N. N. E. Squalls and Rainy.

Monday March 7th

Commences moderate breeze and squally from W. by S. Steering N. by E. and N. N. E. Middle and Latter part much the same Wind from the Westward Steering to the Northward. Ends Cloudy

Tuesday March 8th

Continues moderate breeze from N. N. W. heading to the North. Middle part light breeze from S. S. W. Steering N. by W. Latter part the same

Wednesday March 9th

First part light breeze from N. N. E. Steering N. W. Middle part the same Latter part fresh breeze from N. N. E. Steering N. W. by the Wind. Employed in various jobs.

Thursday March 10th

Continues fresh trades Steering N. W. Middle and Latter parts fresh trades and squally with rain Steering N. W.

Friday March 11th

The Wind and Weather the same Steering N. W. Middle and Latter part Strong breeze and squalls with a thick dirty rain Storm Steering N. W. by N.

Continues much the same Steering N. W. and W. N. W. 4 P.M. passed the Island of Assention to the Westward of us. distance 16 or 15 miles. Middle part Strong breeze from N. N. E. Steering N. W. by W. Latter part the same. Split P. S. sail under it and bent another. Steering N. W.

Sunday March 13th

Continues Strong breeze from N. E. Steering N. W. and N. W. by N. quite rugged. Middle part Steered N. N. W. Latter part Steered N. W. Ends strong breeze and rugged

Latt Obs 10.14 N. Long by Chro 153.30 E

Monday March 14th

Strong breeze first part of these 24 hours from N. E. and hazy weather Steering W. N. W. Middle and Latter part the same

Latt Obs 11.42 N. Long 154.10 E

Tuesday March 15th

Continues Strong breeze from N. E. Steering W. N. W. attended with squally and rain Middle and Latter part Strong breeze and squally Steering W. N. W. Employed in sundry jobs.

Latt Obs 13.17 N. Long by Chro 148.00 E

Wednesday March 16th

These 24 hours commences the same as the former Steering W. by N. N. W. bent a new Fore Top 8th Sail. Middle part Steered W. by N. at 5 AM. Saw the Island of Guam bearing S. E. W. and Steered for it at 6.6 took a Pilot at 11.6 came to anchor in 25 fathoms water and furlled the sails found the ship Julian and the Briganzas of Mexico the 13 regency 40 bbl. Julian Chan
