

Remarks on Board of Bark Ontario N.Y.

Monday April 11th 1864

Commenced Moderate breeze from the N.W. steering N.W. by N. Middle part shortened sail to double reef and stood on during the night. Latter part made sail and steered by the wind to the northward wind N.W. Saw one of the Bonine Islands to the N.W.

Salt lbs 26.25 N. Long by Chron 142.40 E

Tuesday April 12th

First part Moderate breeze from N.W. and hazy steering by the wind to N.W. the Island in sight. Sunset shortened sail daylight made all sail and steered various courses wind from the Eastward 2 or 3 Islands in sight.

Salt lbs 26.33 N. Long by Chron 142.50 E

Wednesday April 13th

Continued much the same saw Humpbacks. Middle and Latter part light Easterly wind and fine weather steering various ways 2 or 3 Islands in sight & Pinbacks. Watcher employed in various jobs.

Salt lbs 26.54 N. Long by Chron 142.22 E

Thursday April 14th

Wind and weather about the same the first part of this day. Middle part Moderate breeze from the South steering N.E. Latter part fresh breeze steering N.E. Watcher employed in various little jobs.

Salt lbs 28.22 N. Long by Chron 143.40 E

Friday April 15th

Continued fresh breeze from S.W. and smoky steering N.E. by E. Middle and Latter part Moderate breeze from S.W. steering N.E. by E. Saw Pinbacks. Watcher employed as usual in odd jobs.

Salt lbs 29.42 N. Long by Chron 146.00 E

Saturday April 16th 1864

Commenced Moderate breeze from N.W. steering N.E. and N.E. by N. Saw Pinbacks. Middle and Latter part fresh breeze from N.W. heading E. N.E. by the wind. Ends the same.

Salt lbs 30.40 N. Long by Chron 148.20 E

Sunday April 17th

Commenced fresh breeze from N.W. heading N.E. & N.E. by E. Middle and Latter part strong breeze and rapid from N.W. heading N.E. by E.

Salt lbs 31.30 N. Long by Chron 149.50 E

Monday April 18th

Commenced rather more moderate from N.W. heading N.E. by E. Middle and Latter part much the same. Employed in sundry jobs.

Salt lbs 32.20 N. Long by Chron 151.13 E

Tuesday April 19th

First part light breeze from N.W. heading to the N.E. Middle and Latter part light air and calm. Employed breaking out for water &c.

Salt lbs 32.40 N. Long by Chron 151.45 E

Wednesday April 20th

Light air from S.E. the first part of this day heading N.W. by E. Saw Pinbacks. The remainder of this day Moderate breeze from S.E. steering N.W. by E. Saw Pinbacks.

Salt lbs 33.59 N. Long by Chron 152.34 E

Thursday April 21st

Moderate breeze the first part of this day from the South steering N.W. by E. Middle and Latter part fresh breeze from S.W. and hazy & smoky weather steering N.W. by E. Ends & ends.
