

Remarks on Board of Bark Ontario of N. Ys.

Friday April 22nd 1864

Commenced Strong breeze from the N.W. W. Steering N.W. E. inclining to a Gale 7th P.M. close reefed and hoisted the boat on upper crane & reefed to the wind. Middle and latter part Strong Gale from the Northward heading E. N. E. Lat Obs 37.16 N. Long by Chron 75.04 E

Saturday April 23rd

Rather more moderate the first part of this day heading N.W. W. Middle part moderate breeze from S.E. Steering N.W. E. Latter part fresh breeze. Mended M. S. Sail to repair Lat Obs 38.22 N. Long by Chron 135.44 E

Sunday April 24th

Continued fresh breeze from S.E. Steering N.W. E. finished Main Top Sail and bent it. Middle and latter part Strong breeze and rainy dirty weather from S.E. Steering N.W. E. No Obs

Monday April 25th

First part Strong breeze from S.W. and rugged steering N.W. E. Middle part a gale from S.W. took in all sail but Main sail & M. Spencer. Split Main sail luffed to the wind to the Westward Latter part Strong Gale & rugged. So Endz

Tuesday April 26th

Continued Strong Gale from Westward heading to the Northward. Middle and latter part light air. Mended Main and Fore Top Sails to repair finished them and bent them again bent new F. S. Main Sail

Continued light air from the N.W. W. Steering N.W. E. Middle part the same. Latter part Moderate breeze from S.E. Steering N. by E. bent a Fore and main Stay Sail. Mended Spicaker and bent close Mizzen and various other Sails

Thursday April 28th

Commenced Moderate breeze from S.E. Steering N. by E. Middle part Shortened Sail to Storm Sails and luffed by the wind. Latter part wind from S.W. Set Main S. Sail and Fore Sail and Steer S. by

Commenced Strong breeze and thick weather from W. S. W. Steering N. by E. Middle and latter part fresh breeze from S.W. Steering N. by E. Employed in building a Crow Nest in fore top mast Cross tree and various other Sails

Saturday April 30th

Continued fresh breeze from S.W. Steering N. by E. Middle and latter part Moderate weather and gentle breeze from W. S. W. Steering N. by E. Employed in various little Sails

Lat Obs 50.47 N. Long by Chron 163.02 E

Sunday May 1st

Continued fine clear weather wind W. S. W. Steering N. by E. Middle part the same. Latter part light air from N.E. and Snow Squalls heading to N.W. by the wind. Saw Finbacks

Lat Obs 52.15 N. Long by Chron 163.46 E

Tuesday May 2nd

Commenced fresh breeze from N.E. heading N.W. W. Middle and latter part much the same. Saw Hornsbacks & Kittiw
