Monday September 26th 1864th finished boiling

The weather continues the same saw R.W. and lowered for them but could not hook one saw a strange sail. Arnold's cutting. Middle part the same. Latter part thick and rainier steering to the westward. So ends this day

Thick and Rainy
Tuesday Sept 27th

Strong breezy and thick weather from N. E. Steering S. E. Middle part the same. Latter part moderate breezy and smoky from N. E. Steering S. E. by S. took down the cross Mast. bent fore top 9th sail and P. T. Mast Studding and lower Studding sail and set them. So ends

Sat Obs 58.26 N. Long by Chro 173.10 W
Wednesday Sept 28th

Commence moderate breezy from N. E. and smoky weather steering S. E. by S. took in the cutting stage &c. Middle and latter part light air from N. W. E. Steering S. E. by S. Foggy & visibility light

Sat Obs 57.30 N. Long by Chro 172.20 W
Thursday Sept 29th

Moderate breezy the first part of this day from North. Steering S. E. by S. Foggy saw 3 ships. a R. W. and 2 bark. Stowed down the oil between decks 45 bbls. Middle and latter part strong breezy from N. W. E. Steering S. E. by S. and S. E. Under 2 reef topsails jibs and courses. So ends

Sat Obs 54.15 N. Long by Chro 171.45 W
Friday Sept 30th

Continues strong breezy from S. W. Steering S. E. 4 P.M. Stowed South. Middle and latter part strong breezy and thick weather saw what we supposed was land bearing N. E. distance 20 miles and stowed for the passage between the Fox Islands called the 1st passage. So ends

Continues strong breezy from E. N. E. Steering S. E. Middle and latter part moderate breezy from N. E. Steering from S. E. by S. to E. S. E. fine weather

Sunday Oct 2nd

Commence moderate breezy from the N. W. W. Steering from S. E. to East with full sail. Middle part moderate. Latter part fresh breezy from the N. W. Steering from E. S. E. to E. N. E. saw a sail

Sat Obs 56.16 N. Long by Chro 166.56 W
Monday Oct 3rd

Continues fresh breezy from N. W. Steering E. N. E. attended with light shower of rain in squalls. Middle and latter part moderate breezy from N. W. W. to S. W. Steering East and E. by S. Employed variously

Sat Obs 49.27 N. Long by Chro 162.24 W
Tuesday Oct 4th

First part moderate breezy from S. E. W. Steering East 4 P.M. wind S. E. heading by the wind to the E. N. E. Middle part strong breezy. Latter part fresh breezy from S. W. Steering East. So ends

Sat Obs 49.07 N. Long by Chro 158.50 W
Wednesday Oct 5th

Continues strong breezy from the westward Steering East. Middle and latter part strong breezy from S. W. Steering East. Employed variously

Sat Obs 48.04 N. Long by Chro 154.38 W
Thursday Oct 6th

Continues the same. Middle and latter part strong breezy from S. E. W. to W. S. W. Steering East. Employed in raising jibs.
