

Remarks on Board of Bark Pacific S. R.

Sunday July 9th 1863

Commences light breeze from S.W. and cloudy steering by the wind to N.W. Middle part lying aback. Latter part moderate steering to the N.E. Saw 2 strange vessels 8 AM spoke Bark Mantis Belvin sailed same day we did with nothing ends cloudy inclining to rain

Monday July 10th

Continues the same 3 P.M. Rain storm. Middle part lying aback. Latter part wind from N.W. steering to Eastward 2 strange ships in sight. Watch employed variously. Caught 2 Porpoises.

Sat Obs 17. 12 N. Long by Chro 28. 01 10

Tuesday July 11th

Commences moderate breeze and fine weather from N.W. steering South saw Hump back. Caught a Porpoise. Middle part moderate under short sail. Latter part fresh breeze and cloudy from N.W. steering South and S.E. Nothing in sight worth of remark.

Sat Obs 45. 12 N. Long by Chro 26. 43 10

Wednesday July 12th

First part fresh breeze and thick hazy weather from N.W. heading N.W. by the wind. Middle part strong breeze. Latter part strong breeze from N.W. steering N.W. by the wind one ship in sight saw Porpoise caught 2. So ends

Sat Obs 45. 10 N. Long by Chro 27. 46 10

Thursday July 13th

Commences strong breeze from N.W. heading N.W. by the wind. 4 P.M. spoke Bark Daniel Wood Richmond of N.B. 2 fine 50 lbs spars. Light breeze through the night. Latter part fresh breeze steering S.W. ends steering N.W. W. cloudy

Sat Obs 43. 55 N

Attn. Master. Cruising in Atlantic Ocean

Friday July 14th 1863

Commences fresh breeze from S.W. and hazy weather heading N.W. W. One ship in sight the remainder of this day strong Gale and Rugged from N.W. heading to W. S.W. under storm sails. So ends

Saturday July 15th

Throughout these 24 hours strong Gale from the North and Rugged heading to the Westward. Saw 2 strange ships. Ship at sea which stole the light & S. ends Pleasant but Rugged

Sat Obs 42. 30 N. Long by Chro 29. 50 10

Sunday July 16th

Continues strong breeze but fairer heading N.W. by S. wind North. Carpenter mending the light. Middle part moderate. Latter part strong breeze from S.W. and cloudy thick dirty weather heading one ship in sight. Ends Rainy

No Obs

Monday July 17

First part strong breeze from S.W. and thick Rainy weather heading N.W. W. by the wind. Middle part more moderate. Latter part fine weather and gentle breeze from West N.W. steering N.W. by the wind saw Fishbacks and 2 strange sails. Watch employed variously

Sat Obs 42. 38 N. Long by Chro 31. 43 10

Tuesday July 18th

Commences fine weather and gentle breeze from N.W. steering S.W. Employed setting up topmast back stays. Middle part light breeze from N.W. heading to the S.W. Latter part calm and hazy. Watch employed in various jobs one ship in sight and Fishbacks
