M. back in the Main Mast Middle part Light Breezes and all Sail set and 2 Sail in Litter latter part Light Breezes from the N W and pleasant weather and steering S W by S per Compass and the Cook Dick of Duty and J. James Selley Dick of Duty and Bailey Dick of Duty & on these 24 hours
