This Day Commenced with fresh breezes from the S by E with cloudy weather and steering E by N per Compass and Double Reefed the top Sail 7 AM took in the Main Sail and took the Cook Deck of Duty and Kitchen Deck and William Russell Deck of Duty 7 AM took in the fore and Mizen top Sail Middle part heavy gales and took in the fore Sail and let the Spencer 7 AM let the fore Sail and steering N by W per Compass To end 24 hours

This Day Commenced with light airs from the N by W with smoky weather and steering N by E per Compass and the Hatch employed on Ship Duty and fore and Mizen top Sail to Valparaiso and the Cook Deck of Duty and Kitchen Deck of Duty Middle part calm latter part light breezes from the N by W with very smoky weather and heading N by E per Compass and 2 Brig in Sight To end these 24 hours
