this Day Commenced with Calm and foggy weather and all hands well and the Stewart down in the Run in irons Middle port Latter part Light airs from the Eastward and Steering SW by Compass Do and these 24 hours

this Day Commenced with Calm and Clear weather and all hands well and the Stewart down in the Run in irons and one Ship in Site Middle port foggy weather and Laying back Latter part from the Eastward and Rain weather and in Company with the Ship Amazon Do and these 24 hours

this Day Commenced with Light Wind from Eastward Middle port Laying a Back 6 AM the Wind Canted to the Westward with Clear weather and Site the island Oumismak Latter part Working up in N to the Strait of Aboulin Do and these 24 hours

this Day Commenced with fresh Breezes from the Westward with Clear weather and all hands well and the Run Raring for Compass from W to NW 4 PM Come on foggy weather and Double Rigs this Ship Last Latter part Clear weather and Light Breezes from the WNW and Working about Oumismak Straits Do and these 24 hours

Remarks on Board Friday June the 29

this Day Commenced with Light airs from the WNW and Light foggy weather and Working about Oumismak Straits in Company with Ship Amazon 4 PM Calm and Light foggy weather and the Land bearing for Compass E by S distant 5 Miles 5 PM Bent the Cable 10 PM got a Light Breezes from the ESE and Steering WNW Middle port Rain weather 4 AM on Bent the Cable Latter part thick weather and Saw a number hump back Do and these 24 hours

Remarks on Board Saturday June the 30

this Day Commenced with fresh Breezes from the ESE with thick Rain weather and Steering W by N and all hands well and Stewart down in the Run in irons 6 PM Saw 2 White Whales Close to the Ship Sawed Boats Whales got Site of the Ship on West of the Hindward 9 PM Hook up the Boats and Shorten Sail for the Night Middle port Clear weather Latter part Light foggy weather and Wind from the NW 11 PM Site a large island and near Ship to SW Do and 24 hours
