This Day Commenced with Light Wind from the NE with Smoky Weather and Went Ont Stone Deck of Duty Stewart Down in the Storege in irons Middle part Steering S by E 9 A.M. Saw one whale and lowered 2 boats and Chase him and one Ship in Lite this Day End with fine pleasant Weather

Remarks on board Monday August the 13

This Day Commenced with fine pleasant Weather and Light breezes from the NNE and Chase Whales and the whale got Lite of the boats and Went of the Windward 2 P.M. give up the Chase and tack up the boat Ont Stone Deck of Duty Stewart Down in the Storege in irons Middle part Light airs and thick foggy weather Latter part Calm with foggy Weather and Saw 2 Whales Close to the Ship and lowered 2 boats and Chase them so and this Day

This Day Commenced with Light airs and Calm with Light foggy Weather and in Chase of Whales 4 P.M. give up the Chase and tack up the boat Middle part heading SE and Rain Weather Latter part Wind from the SSE and Saw 1 Number hump back and lowered 3 boats and Chase them with out one success this Day End with Rain Weather

Lite Island and Bearing per Compass SE by S Middle part Came on fresh gales with Rain and tack in all Gail but I Close Reel main top Gail Latter part the gale moderate and Lat Double Reel top Gail and Course and thick foggy Weather so and Day
