Remarks on board Friday August the 24

this Day Commenced with fresh breezes from the N.W. with Clear Weather and Employed Cutting in 6 P.M. finish Out line Tack of Duty Stewart Down in the Charge in irons middle part Employed hauling Latter part Light breezes and 2 Ships in Lite and 1 Number for back to end these 24 hours

Remarks on board Saturday August the 25

this Day Commenced with fine pleasant Weather and Light breezes from the N.W. and Employed hauling and 1 Number for back in Lite 7 P.M. Saw one Whale and Lower the boats and Chase him with out One Success 7 P.M. Shorten Sail for the Night Latter part Wind from the S.W. with Smoky weather and 1 Number for back in Lite and 2 Whales to end this Day

Remarks on board Sunday August the 26

this Day Commenced with Light Wind from the S.W. with Smoky Weather and Employed hauling and Chase Whales 2 P.M. one Boat struck and got foul Line and the Boat Capsized and Lets the Line 7 P.M. give the Whale up and took up the boats and put the 2 Mate of Duty Mr Slater middle part Wind from the Eastward 6 P.M. finish hauling Latter part Rain Weather and Employed Stowing Down to end these 24 hours

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Remarks on board Monday August the 27

this Day Commenced with fresh breezes from the Eastward with Thick Rain Weather and Employed Stowing Down 7 P.M. finish Out line Tack of Duty Stewart Down in the Store in irons middle part Light breezes with thick foggy Weather 9 P.M. Saw 2 Whales 9 P.M. Lower the boats 10 P.M. struck one Latter part thick foggy Weather and the boats fast to 8 Whales to end these 24 hours

Remarks on board Tuesday August the 28

this Day Commenced with Light Wind and foggy Weather and the boats fast to Whale 4 P.M. took him to the Ship and back on to him and Commenced Cutting in and Rain Weather 6 P.M. Lash Down for the Night middle part fine pleasant Weather Latter part finish Cutting in to end these 24 hours

Remarks on board Wednesday August the 29

this Day Commenced with Light Breezes and Calm and one Whale in Lite 4 P.M. Lowered the boats and Chase him with out One Success middle part Employed hauling and thick foggy Weather Latter part fresh breezes and Cloudy Weather and one Ship in Lite and 1 Number for back in Lite to end these 24 hours
