Remarks on board Sunday September the 23

this Day Commenced with fresh breezes from the N.W. and Breeze Weather and 5 Ships in Site and 2 boats 2 P.M. Double Reefed the top Sail 4 P.M. spoke the Ship Lydia fairhaven 600 lbs. this season middle part fresh gales and Squally weather latter part Cloudy weather and Laying to heading N.W. 8 I fore Sail and Close Reefed main top Sail Do End these 24 hours

Remarks on board Monday September the 24

this Day Commenced with fresh gales from the N.W. and Cloudy weather and Breeze weather and Laying to heading N.W. by N. I fore Sail set and Close Reefed main top Sail 4 P.M. took in the fore Sail middle part the gale moderate 6 A.M. Let Double Reefed top Sail latter part steering of South and 9 Ships in Site and Squally weather Do End this Day

Remarks on board Tuesday September the 25

this Day Commenced with fresh gales from the N. and Breeze weather and Squally and steering S 7 Ships in Site 2 men of Duty 16 P.M. Close Reefed the main top Sail and took in the fore and mizen top Sail and fore Sail bore to heading W by S middle part blowing very heavy and Squally weather latter part pleasant gales and 8 large ships running 4 Ships in Site Do End these 24 hours

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Remarks on board Wednesday September the 26

this Day Commenced with heavy gales from the N.W. with pleasant weather and 8 large ships running and Laying to Close Reefed main top Sail and fore heading W by N 1 P.M. ran Ship to the N.W. and 2 Ships in Site middle part the gale more moderate 1 P.M. Let the fore Sail and steering of S by E latter part set all Sail and steering S by E Do End these 24 hours

Remarks on board Thursday September the 27

this Day Commenced with fine pleasant weather and light wind from the Westward and steering S by E all day set 2 P.M. saw 8 Sea Whales 3 P.M. took down to the ship 4 P.M. Commenced cutting in 9 P.M. finish and let the sail middle part steering W by N and the sail bearing per compass S by E latter part steering East and spoke the last Red Mizen 300 lbs. this season Do End these 24 hours

Remarks on board Friday September the 28

this Day Commenced with fine pleasant weather and light wind from the Westward and steering E by S per compass and the sail bearing per compass S by E by S and employed hauling middle part steering E by S per compass latter part wind from the S.E. with thick foggy weather and steering W by N Do End these 24 hours
