This Day Commenced with Calm and fine weather and Laying up and on At Waikoo Middle port in company with 6 Ships 4 PM sent up the 1st Creekst in the middle port latter part the weather much the same to End Day

Remarks on Board Friday 7 March the 7

This Day Commenced with Light Breezes and Calm and fine pleasant weather and Laying up and on At Waikoo Middle port 11 AM, heard a man shout in the water and at 4 PM lowered a boat and pick him up and he told me that he left the Southern Light 11 AM at 9 o'clock that light his kite had been hit every day by a shark and stuck him on back middle port Calm latter part same to End Day

Remarks on Board Saturday March the 8

This Day Commenced with fine pleasant weather and Laying up and on At Waikoo Joseph I saw him I saw Antoine comes to Joseph Behmore John Thomas Thompson George Jernath Ship on Board Middle port Calm latter the men return on Board to End these 24 hours

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Remarks on Board Sunday March the 9

This Day Commenced with fine weather and Light Breezes from NW and Laying up and on At Waikoo Middle port Steering for Atami Maui 9 AM Laid out 24 hours Ship in late to End these 24 hours

Remarks on Board March the 10

This Day Commenced with fine pleasant weather and Light Breezes from NW and all hands well and of Atami Middle port came on Equally weather and Steering 9 AM latter part fresh gales and Rain kept the ship to End Day
