Remarks on Board Saturday April the 26

this Day Commenced with Light Breezes from the NE with thick foggy weather and heading in to the SE all sail set and all hands well 5 P.M. saw 2 Whales close to the ship and Shorten'd sail for the night middle part Calm and thick Rain weather at 9 A.M. Wind from the NW with weather and 5 ships in sight at 10 A.M. saw 2 Whales and saw 2 Boats and one Boat struck and crew from him and took up Boats and spoke William Badger with nothing this season to end Day Left By Dr 28 45

this Day Commenced with fresh gales from the Westward with Clear weather and George Lued and Steering of to the Eastward with Double Reef top sail set and 2 ships in sight and all hands well 3 P.M. saw one Whale and saw 3 Boats and struck him and the fore part 5 P.M. took up the Boats 7 P.M. Shorten'd sail for the night middle part 5 P.M. set all sail and 2 ships in sight 7 P.M. came in thick foggy weather and Steering to the Eastward to end Day
