Thursday May the 01 1856

Remarks on Board Thursday April the 31

this Day Commenced with fresh gales from the SW with thick foggy weather and heading by the wind WNW with Double Reefed topsail Set and all hands well At 7 PM Shorten Sail for the Night middle part Light Breeze latter part calm and foggy weather and one ship in sight and then I hauled down the main and foremast and lowered the boats for them to go by

Remarks on Board Friday May the 2

this Day Commenced with Light Breezes from the N with foggy weather and heading by the wind W to the WNW all sail Set and all hands well middle part fresh Breezes and tack in the fore and main topsail At 5 PM made all sail and steering NE per Compass latter part Light Breezes and Smoky weather and one ship in sight to end these 24 hours

Remarks on Board Saturday May the 3

this Day Commenced with Light Breezes from the WNW and Smoky weather and steering NE per Compass and all hands well middle part steering NE by latter part calm and nothing in sight and all hands well to end these 24 hours

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Remarks on Board Sunday May the 4

this Day Commenced with Light Breezes from the SW and Smoky weather and steering NE by per Compass all sail Set and all hands well and one ship in sight 5 PM I put the ship on a course of Head Redford with Nothing this season middle part steering ENE per Compass latter part the winds and weather much the same to end these 24 hours

Remarks on Board Monday May the 5

this Day Commenced with Light Breezes from the SE with Smoky weather and steering NE by per Compass all sail Set and all hands well and one ship in sight middle part Laying to Back latter part Light Breezes from the ESE and heading NE by N and later the land the Long Range per Compass NE by N 8 Miles and tack ship of there to end these 24 hours

Remarks on Board Tuesday May the 6

this Day Commenced with fresh Breezes from the ESE and Rain through the Strait of Matsmai in Company with ship Ontario 7 PM fresh gales and Double Reefed the topsail and 2 ships in sight middle part latter part fine clear weather and working up in the Strait and 3 ships in sight to end these 24 hours
