this Day Commenced with Light Breezes and Calm and I Number 22 whales in sight and the Boats in Chase at 3 PM one Boat struck and got him at 5 PM got him to the Ship and hook on and cut him in and come to anchor at 2 PM finish cutting at 5 PM got under way latter part Employed Bailing to End Day

Remarks on Board Sunday June the 15

this Day Commenced with fresh Breezes from the NW and E Clear weather and Employed Bailing middle part Calm latter part Rain weather and in Chase of whales and struck one to End Day

Remarks on Board Monday June the 16

this Day Commenced with Light Breezes from the Eastward and the Boats fast to whale at 1 PM took him to the Ship and hook on to him at 1 PM finish cutting latter part fresh Breezes to End Day

Remarks on Board Tuesday June the 17

this Day Commenced with Light Breezes from the Eastward and Employed Bailing and all hands well and no whales in sight to Day middle Light Breezes and Calm latter part Employed Stowing Down and Bailing

Remarks on Board Wednesday June the 18

this Day Commenced with fresh Breezes from NW and Employed Bailing and Stowing Down at 4 PM came on fresh gales latter part moderate Breezes to End this Day

this Day Commenced with fresh Breezes from the NW and Clear weather and Employed Bailing and Stowing Down and all hands well and Employed Bailing and the Stowing Down middle part latter part in Chase of whales to End Day

this Day Commenced with Calm and pleasant weather and Employed Stowing Down latter part Light Breezes to End these 24 hours

Remarks on Board Saturday June the 21

this Day Commenced with fine weather and Light Breezes from the NW and Clear weather and Employed Stowing Down at 1 PM finish and spoke the Ship Navy with Katching this Season latter part Light foggy weather

Remarks on Board Sunday June the 22

this Day Commenced with fresh Breezes from the SSE and Light foggy weather and saw I Number whales and Chase them and 5 Ships in sight one Bailing middle part latter part Calm and Boats in Chase of whales 15 Ships in 2 Bailing

Remarks on Board Monday June the 23

this Day Commenced with fine weather and Light Breezes from the Westward and saw one whale and Number Ships in sight at 7 PM spoke the Ship Sparachute 1 whale this Season middle part fresh Breezes latter part foggy weather at 10 AM Clear weather and the Captain went on Shore to End these 24 hours
