Remarks on Board Sunday July the 13

this Day Commence with fresh Breezes from the SE and thick Rain weather and the Boats up the Bay At 3 PM 2.4 Return on Board At 5 PM. The 2 Boats on Board and Boat had got a whale At 6 PM got under way and the Wind Die a Way and Calm and a large swell on and Come to Anchor the Mast Boat had 2 men Run a Way William Herbert and Isaac Kellogg At 9 AM got under way to End these 24 hours

Remarks on Board Monday July the 14

this Day Commence with Light Breezes and Calm and working up the Bay to get the whale Middle part Wind from the NW At 1 AM Come to Anchor At 4 PM Saw the Boat and whale Wind from the ESE and thick Rain weather and sent the Boats After the whale At 9 AM took him to the Ship and hook on and Blowing a heavy gale from the ESE and a heavy Sea Running and Bent the other Cable to End these 24 hours

Remarks on Board Tuesday July the 15

this Day Commence with heavy gale from the ESE and thick Rain weather and empty Cutting in At 9 PM finish and the gale moderate and a heavy swell on middle part Blowing heavy from the SE At 9 AM got under way and went up the Bay and Come to Anchor to End these 24 hours

this Day Commence with fresh gales from the ESE and Rain weather and Frying At Anchor and all hands well in Employe Railing middle part Latter part fresh Breezes and Employe Railing and 2 Boats up the Bay to End Day

Remarks on Board Thursday July the 17

this Day Commence with fresh Breezes and Rain weather 5 PM finish Railing and the Boats Return on Board and Load the whale Latter part Employe Stowing down to End Day

Remarks on Board Friday July the 18

this Day Commence with fine weather and Wind from the NW and Employe Stowing down and sent one Boat down to Shale Water Bay to Look for the 2 men that Run a Way Latter part sent the 3 Boats down the Bay to Look for for Whales to End the Day

Remarks on Board Friday July the 19

this Day Commence with fine weather and Wind from the NW and all the Boats up the whale At 4 PM 5 Boats Return on Board Saw 5 whales Could not get on them and sent the Boats in After water Latter part sent 2 Boats up the Bay fishing and thick foggy weather

Remarks on Board Sunday July the 20

this Day Commence with fresh Breezes from the NW and thick foggy weather and 2 Boats up the Bay fishing and one Boat down in Shale Water Bay Middle part fresh Breezes At 5 PM the other Boats Return on Board Latter part Calm and all Ready for Sea to End this Day
