Remarks on Board Saturday August the 2

this Day Began with Light Winds and Smoky weather from the S.E. and one Man Sick of Duty and heading of our compass middle part Light Breeze and steering S.W. by S latter part thick foggy weather to end this Day

Remarks on Board Sunday August the 3

this Day Commenced with fresh Breezes from the S.E. with thick foggy weather and heading to the Westward all sail set and one Man Sick of Duty at 3 P.M. Clear weather and sight the Chukchi islands middle part working up to Chukchi Bay latter part 3 ships in sight and spoke ship young of Bennett of New Bedford 700 miles this morning to end these 24 hours

Remarks on Board Monday August the 4

this Day being with Light Winds from the South and Smoky weather and steering up to Chukchi Bay one Man Sick of Duty middle part Light and Calm at 9 A.M. Come anchor in the kila reef and thick foggy weather and Rain weather to end Day

Ship moved to the Chukchi island 1856

Remarks on Board Tuesday July the 5

this Day Commenced with Light Winds from the South and thick Rain weather and sent 2 Boats shore after New at 8 P.M. Return on Board middle part fresh gales from the S.W. W. and Squally weather latter part moderate gales and pleasant weather and Employed Steaming all Day had to end these 24 hours

Remarks on Board Wednesday August 6

this Day Began with fresh gales from the W. N. W. and pleasant weather and sent 2 Boats shore heading and one Man Sick of Duty latter part all hands Employed sailing to end this Day fine pleasant weather

Remarks on Board Thursday August the 7

this Day Began with fine pleasant weather and the Boats heading latter part sent 3 Boats to look for Whales middle part 1 Boat Return Return on Board saw 2 Whales in the ice to end Day

Remarks on Board Friday August the 8

this Day Began with fine weather and the Boats all Row and Ship at Steamer by the name McGill for 135 Tons and 1000 lbs. by the name Minnelli Commerce for 165 Tons and 1 Boat Steer by the name Bull Silene to end the Day
