this Day Being with heavy gales from the ENE and thick Rain weather and a large Sea running and Laying to Anchor Middle part the gale moderate. Latter part equal weather. Do End these

Remarks on Board Friday September the 26
this Day Being with fresh gales from the NE and squally weather and Laying to Anchor Latter part Chase Whales &c End

Remarks on Board Saturday September 27

this Day Being with fresh Breezes NE and squally weather and the Boats Chase in Whales one Boat got on and struck and got him 4 PM took him to the ship and hauled on and thick Rain weather 6 PM Lash down for the night 7 AM finish and get under way Do End

Remarks on Board Sunday September the 28
this Day Being with fine weather and Wind from the NE At 6 PM Come to Anchor At 5 PM Laying for Whales and ship to Whales Latter part Boats there Working Do End the Day

Remarks on Board Monday September 29

this Day Being with fine weather and Boats there Working At 1 PM Return on Board with the Wood Middle part fresh Breezes from NE Latter part Rain and squally weather Do End the Day

Remarks on Board Tuesday September 30
this Day Being with fresh gales from the ENE and Rain weather and squally middle part blowing heavy from NNE and Rain Latter part squally and a heavy Sea running &c End the Day

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Remarks on Board Wednesday October 1

this Day Being with heavy gales from the NW and clear weather and a large Sea running and 14 Ships to Anchor Middle part the gale moderate At 3 AM Commenced Hauling At 9 AM sent 2 Boats on shore for Wood and Light Winks and 4 Ships Hauling Do End the Day

Remarks on Board Thursday October the 2
this Day Being with fine pleasant weather and Light Winks from the NE and Employed Hauling and 2 Boats there Working 7 PM Return on Board Middle part Win Can to the with some weather Latter part fresh gales and finish Hauling Do End

Remarks on Board Friday October the 3

this Day Being with fresh gales from the NW and cloudy weather and blowing heavy and 2 Ships Hauling in all hands well Middle part the gale moderate Latter part Employed Hauling down and 3 men Lack of Duty Do End these 24 hours

Remarks on Board Saturday October 4

this Day Being with fresh gales from the NW with clear weather and Employed Hauling down At 2 PM finish and 2 men Lack of Duty At 6 AM got under way and hauled to Pick his stuff with Win from the NW and clear weather and blowing fresh gales Do End these 24 hours
